The Center for the Rural Development of Milot, or CRUDEM Foundation, Inc., is a nonprofit organization which operates Hôpital Sacré Coeur (Sacred Heart Hospital) in Milot, and is the largest private hospital in northern Haiti. Because of the tragic earthquake which devastated Haiti, disaster relief and rebuilding efforts were desperately needed to support the Haitian people and their communities. As part of the Haiti Relief efforts, Sacred Heart Hospital required a prosthetics lab to help service the many people injured by the earthquake who now need prosthesis treatment.

Client Need

The CRUDEM Foundation approached Williams Scotsman's Jacksonville office with the concept of a secure storage container that could be configured into a prosthetics workshop for use in Haiti. Not only did the unit need to accommodate enough space for the prosthetics lab, it also had to be durable and ready for use upon arrival at Sacred Heart Hospital. Faced with a very limited budget and a crucial timeline, Williams Scotsman responded quickly in determining the solution.

The Williams Scotsman Solution

Upon reviewing the existing fleet options available, a container office was determined to be the best solution. In less than a month, Williams Scotsman had a 40' X 8' container office ready for outfitting. Also, to show their support to the Haiti Relief efforts, Williams Scotsman sold the unit at a discounted rate of 80% below the standard selling price.

The Result

Due to the collaborative contributions from several organizations and the local community, the concept transformed a basic container office into a portable, secure prosthetics workshop for Sacred Heart Hospital and the people of northern Haiti. Advanced Prosthetics donated the prosthetics shop equipment while Atlantic Marine outfitted the container. Also, several retail organizations and suppliers such as Home Depot, Sears, Wal-Mart, Advanced Furniture Solutions, and Exact Inc donated the furniture for the unit. Lastly, Suddath International offered their services by delivering the prosthetics lab to the local port for exporting.
