Williams Scotsman Awarded Modular Facilities Contract at Fort Bliss *Strengthens Company's Commitment to Growth in Military Sector*

Baltimore, Maryland – October 3, 2005 – Williams Scotsman International, Inc., a leading provider of mobile and modular space, announced today it has been awarded a multi-million dollar project to provide barracks, administrative buildings, storage facilities, classrooms, and battalion and company headquarter buildings to the Fort Bliss military post in Texas. Williams Scotsman, as part of a team led by Clark Design/Build, LLC, will provide approximately half of the modular facilities under the total contract. The deal will provide Fort Bliss with complete site preparation and turn-key services upon which 199 modular buildings totaling over 350,000 square feet will be constructed.

"This is a very exciting time for us. The Fort Bliss deal further confirms our reputation as a leader in the modular space industry. As we commented in our recent public offering prospectus, the military has planned \$100 million for these types of projects through 2006 and beyond. The speed and flexibility of modular construction fits the ever-changing needs of the military," noted Gerry Holthaus, President and CEO of Williams Scotsman.

According to the U.S. Army Installation Management Institute, modular construction will provide a more flexible solution to the U.S. Army as it reorganizes into smaller, more self-sustaining combat brigades, adjusts to the base closings as a result of BRAC (Base Realignment and Closure), and grows with the return of forces now in South Korea and Europe that need more facilities space.

Joe Lopardo, Vice President of Williams Scotsman who provides leadership for the company's modular building projects, stated, "Modular construction enables the flexibility required to meet rapidly changing needs. The Army, and Fort Bliss in particular, is quickly expanding its forces. The shorter construction time and building quality allowed by our modular process gives the Army more time to focus on training and to meet the increased demand for military intelligence and combat support, while improving quality of life for our troops with secure living, working and learning environments."
